

Lesson #6: Half-Square Hourglass Block

Finished block size: 10" x 10"

Materials Needed	Cutting
Purple Ice Orchid	From each, cut: two 6 ½"squares
Purple Ice Orchid Royal Blue	From each, cut:four 1¾" x 18" strips
Raspberry Copper	From each, cut:two 1 ¾" x 18" strips
Supplies Needed	

Quilter's silver marking pencil

6 ½"-square ruler with a 45 degree diagonal line

Sewing

Note: The half-square triangles required for this Hourglass block are Purple Ice and Orchid 6 ½" squares. Do not trim yet. Refer to those instructions to make four half-square triangles from the made with the same method used in Lesson #4, steps one through three.

- that it is on top of the left half-square triangle. You should be able oriented as shown. Now, fold over the right half-square triangle so square triangles as shown in Diagram I. Make sure the blocks are the seams are pressed toward the Purple Ice fabric. Lay out two half-1. Gather two Purple Ice/Orchid half-square triangles. Make sure to feel the seams nest together.






- Sew 1/2" away from both sides of drawn line. Cut on drawn line. (Diagram II)
- 5. Open up block and press seams in opposite directions as shown in Photo II.
- should measure 5 1/2" square. Rotate the block, realign the ruler, and trim the remaining two sides. The block mark on the ruler. Trim the overhang on the right side and top of the block. Also, align the center intersection of the block with the 2 ¾" intersection hashruler, align the 45-degree diagonal line with the diagonal seam of the block. To trim the blocks to size, refer to Photo III as a guide. Using the 6 ½"-square





